

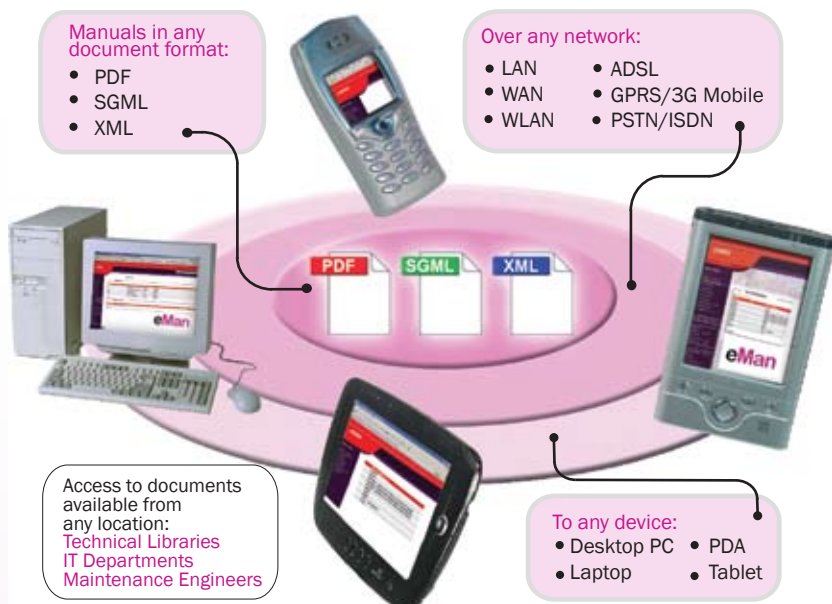

eMan is a full thin-client, Microsoft .NET, server-based software solution that runs on COTS based hardware and software. Offering a set of powerful browser based tools to control, manage and administer all electronic format documentation on local servers, eMan enables any format of documentation to be accessed and viewed from any location, on any device, over any type of communications network via a simple to use and consistent user interface. It helps remove the need for manually tracking and distributing physical copies of aircraft manuals, updates and bulletins which improves the safety and efficiency of the whole documentation process.

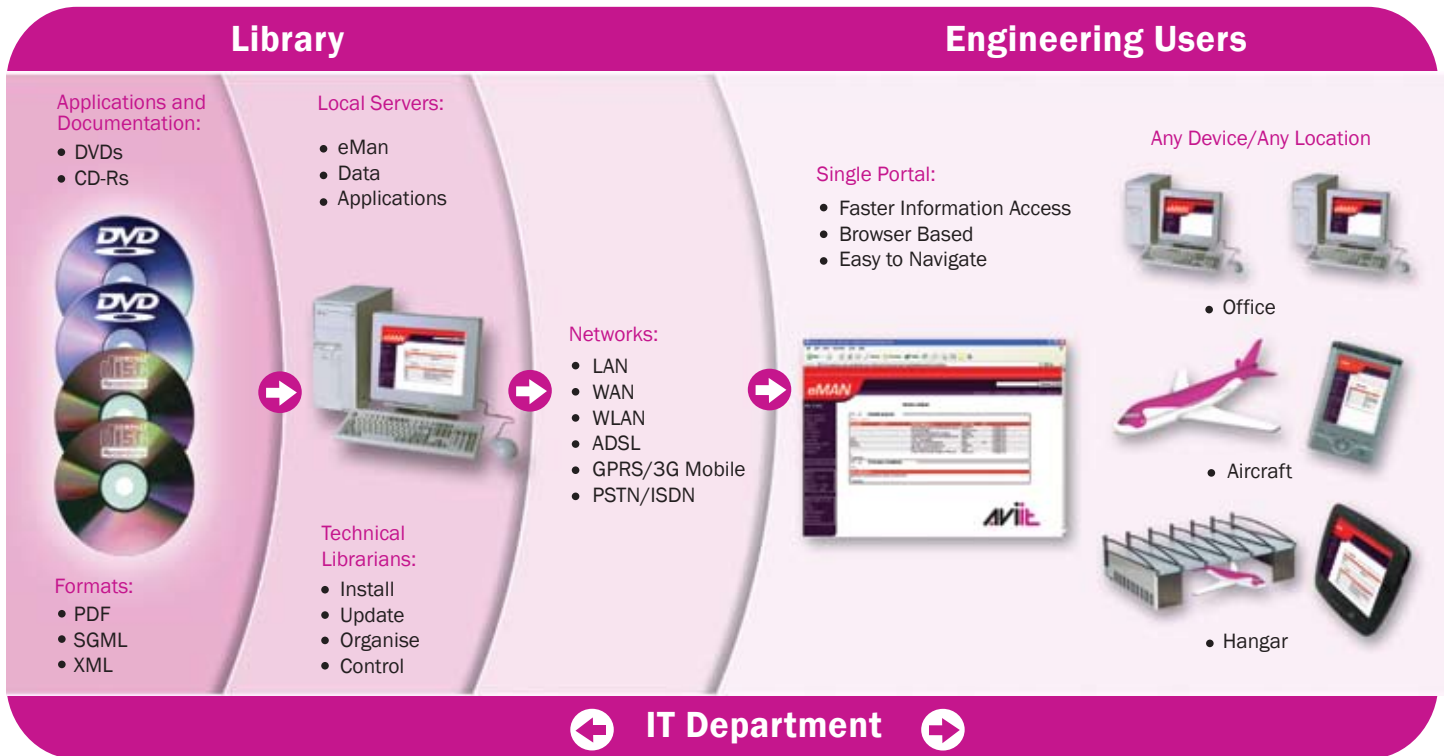
